

Green Chile Food Company HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS

Slack/thaw burritos in case carton or individually in refrigerator for about 48 hours.

Each burrito has a code date stating the date born: YYDDDSS
 (ex. Code 21013101 means burrito was produced in 2021 on the 13th day of the year [1/13/21] during the first shift)
 Egg-based burritos have a 10-day refrigerated shelf life
 Non egg-based burritos have a 14-day refrigerated shelf life

Cold Case Sales: Place thawed individual burritos in refrigerated open display case or reach-in refrigerator. Rotate oldest product to the front. Mark pull date on each package.

Freezer Case Sales: Place individual burritos in open freezer case or reach-in freezer

Burritos have a 12-month freezer shelf life: "Born On Date Stamp" is located on the back of the master case

DELI COOKING AND HOT CASE PROCEDURES

From refrigerated:

- Using microwave (1100 watts maximum), cook on high for 55 seconds in existing packaging for one burrito
- Using conventional oven (no air), cook at 325 degrees for 25 minutes in existing packaging for one burrito or multiple burritos
- Using convection oven (with air), cook at 325 degrees for 20 minutes in existing packaging for one burrito or multiple burritos
- Using Turbo Chef (Model I3), place product on bottom of oven (no tray) and cook at 400 degrees for 50 seconds in existing packaging for one burrito or multiple burritos

Cooking times may vary on oven or microwave type (rotating or stationary) and watt power.

To use in warming/merchandising cabinet:

- Follow same slack/thaw procedures
- Follow same oven/microwave cook time and procedures
- Remove burrito from microwave in paper wrap
- DO NOT REMOVE PAPER WRAP AND LABEL!
- Place packaged burrito in warming/merchandising cabinet and mark time to pull product (4 hours)
- Maintain heat at a minimum of 140 degrees
 Warming/merchandising cabinet hold time is 4 hours
